Govt Approves Redevelopment of Bandra and Worli MHADA Colonies

The Maharashtra Housina and Area Development Authority (MHADA) will oversee the redevelopment of Bandra Reclamation as the sole design and construction authority. Under



this plan, resident societies will appoint a private builder to execute the work on its behalf. The project has been granted a Floor Space Index (FSI) of 4. Of this, one FSI will be allocated for constructing additional homes that will be added to MHADA's housing stock. The redevelopment aims to transform the existing residential are area into a more modern and vertical housing complex.

Located near Lilavati Hospital, the Bandra Reclamation area currently includes 52 buildings with a total of 1,688 flats. These flats vary in size from 322 to 825 square feet and are situated on a plot measuring approximately 2,12,042 square feet. The redevelopment will significantly increase the built-up area, adding around 5,04,515 square metres. As part of the redevelopment, MHADA will receive 1,00,190 square metres of newly constructed housing units. Additionally, the authority is expected to earn a premium of ₹42.66 billion through the project. The construction of taller buildings is also likely to provide sea-facing apartments to existing residents, enhancing the overall value and appeal of the locality.

Prestige Estates Unveils Q4 Projects worth ₹ 161.34 Billion

Prestige Estates Projects reported a significant surge in residential project launches in the fourth quarter of FY25, unveiling 14.03 million sq ft of new developments with a gross development value (GDV) of ₹ 161.33 billion. This marks a substantial increase compared to just 0.83 million sq ft launched in Q4 FY24. For the full fiscal year FY24, the company had launched a total of 31.67 million sq



ft. The Q4 FY25 launches were spread across key real estate markets including Bengaluru, Mumbai, and Hyderabad, encompassing 4,548 residential units. Despite a major portion of these launches occurring in the latter part of the quarter, the company achieved strong sales figures, contributing significantly to its overall performance during the period.

Among the new projects, a development in Mumbai stood out by recording ₹23.85 billion in sales within a month of its launch. Projects in Bengaluru and Hyderabad also performed well, generating ₹ 13.82 billion and ₹ 11.10 billion in sales respectively in the final days of the quarter. These homes will be offered through an online lotterybased system to ensure transparency and fair access. The board also plans to incorporate eco-friendly features and efficient construction practices in line with sustainable development goals. Infrastructure surrounding the housing projects such as roads, parks, and public transport will be improved to support comfortable living.

This scheme is expected to not only address the growing housing needs but also boost the local real estate sector and create employment opportunities during construction and after completion, with urbanisation accelerating across Rajasthan, the Housing Board's proactive approach aims to balance growth with accessibility, helping more families realise their dream of home ownership in rapidly expanding cities.

Lucknow Development Authority Launches 800-acre Housing Scheme

Uttar Pradesh CM Yogi Adityanath inaugurated the Anant Naaar Housing Scheme under the Lucknow Development Authority (LDA), dubbing it a major



step towards providing world-class residential facilities in the city.

The 800-acre Anant Nagar project, developed with an investment of nearly ₹7,000 crore, is located near the international airport, expressway, and Lucknow Ring Road. Designed as an integrated township, the scheme will include reserved spaces for educational institutions, high-rise residential buildings, and affordable housing plots. The project is set to accommodate 1.5 lakh people, with provisions for 10,000 flats and seven plotted sectors. Additionally, 5,000 housing units in the EWS (economically weaker sections) and LIG (lower income group) categories will cater to over 25,000 people. Under the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY), 3,000 homes will be made available.

Additionally, a 130-acre park and an EduTech City are planned as part of the township, ensuring that residents can access primary to higher education and technical and medical institutes.

Trinity to Launch ₹ 12 Bn Luxury Housing **Project in Gurugram**



Trinity, a real estate developer based in the National Capital Region (NCR), has begun construction on its ₹ 12-billion ultraluxury residential project, Sky Palazzo Residences, in Gurugram. Havells Invests ₹ 6 Billion in Goldi Solar To **Strengthen Presence in The Renewables** Sector

Havells India Limited has signed a binding term sheet to invest ₹ 6 billion in Goldi Solar



Private Limited. This investment forms a part of Goldi Solar's proposed fundraise of up to ₹ 13 billion, which is expected to be completed within 75 days from the day of announcement. Havells' investment is a part of a broader effort to expand its presence in the renewable and solar sector through energy generation, storage, distribution, and consumption solutions.

Havells has already been active in the solar ecosystem through the sale of inverters, modules, solar cables, and DC switchgears, particularly within the residential rooftop and commercial and industrial segments. With increasing domestic reliance on solar modules due to policy shifts, Havells has reportedly assessed the need to either establish its own manufacturing base or partner with a module manufacturer. The investment in Goldi Solar reflects this strategic decision.

India's Rooftop Solar Capacity Projected To Reach 25-30 GW By FY27

India's rooftop solar energy capacity is expected to rise significantly from 17 GW to an estimated 25–30 GW between FY25 and FY27, according to a report released on recently. This projected surge is aligned with the country's broader energy transition goals as solar power continues to emerge as a central pillar in India's clean energy roadmap. As per CareEdge Ratings, rooftop solar—especially in the commercial and industrial (C&I) segment—is set to play a critical role in India's renewable growth trajectory. The nation's total renewable energy capacity stood at 220 GW as of FY25, with a target of reaching 300 GW of solar capacity by 2030.

Rooftop solar capacity reached 17.02 GW in FY25. Increased awareness among businesses about reducing operational costs and meeting sustainability goals is driving its rapid adoption. The report highlights that government incentives, declining technology costs, and supportive policies—such as net metering and Production Linked Incentive (PLI) schemes—are expected to further accelerate rooftop solar deployment.

The PM Surya Ghar Muft Bijli Yojana, which aims to install rooftop solar in one crore households with subsidies up to Rs. 78,000, is poised to strengthen residential adoption. The scheme is designed to support low- and middle-income households by reducing electricity bills while also creating nearly 17 lakh jobs, thus boosting the entire solar value chain.

The report notes that the rooftop segment currently accounts for around 20% of India's total solar capacity. Its growing importance is attributed to its distributed nature and direct consumer engagement, despite utility-scale solar remaining the dominant contributor.

Nagaland Launches Solar Mission to **Promote Rooftop Solar**

This initiative complements the national PM Surya Ghar Muft Bijli Yojana, aiming to provide households with more accessible and cost-effective clean energy. The launch ceremony took place at the Chief Minister's Office in Kohima, with key officials including Deputy Chief Minister Y. Patton, Power Minister K G Kenye, and Chief Secretary J. Alam in attendance. Chief Minister Rio announced via social media that the state government will augment the central government's subsidies with additional state-level financial support.

Specifically, residents will receive up to 96 percent subsidy for solar systems up to 2 KW and 85 percent for systems up to 3 KW, drastically reducing the cost of solar installation. He also stated that INR 10 crore has been allocated for the mission in the 2025-26 fiscal year. Rio emphasized that this initiative represents a significant stride towards promoting green energy, lowering electricity expenses, and supporting environmental preservation. He highlighted the state government's dedication to fostering a sustainable and energy-efficient future.

Jupiter International Secures ₹ 5 Billion **Investment for Solar Manufacturing Expansion**



Jupiter International Limited has secured an investment of ₹5 billion from ValueQuest SCALE Fund and its affiliates to support the company's expansion in solar manufacturing. This marks ValueQuest's second round of investment in the company. The new funds, along with internal accruals, will be used for an ongoing capital expenditure programme aimed at scaling up capacity to 5.6 GW of solar cells and 2.4 GW of solar modules. The expansion also aims to establish Jupiter International as a player across the solar manufacturing value chain. Reportedly, the company's strategic focus is on enhancing forward integration, reducing reliance on imports, generating employment, and aligning with the national goals. Additionally, Aum Capital acted as the exclusive financial advisor to Jupiter International for this transaction.

In January 2025, Jupiter International signed a MoU with the government of Odisha to invest ₹ 20.05 billion through its subsidiary, Jupiter Renewables, in setting up a solar cell and module manufacturing unit in Khordha with an annual capacity of 4,200 MW and 3,600 MW respectively.

The DY Patil University Centre of Excellence has been designed to support the teaching methods and ethos of the university, providing high-quality learning and living spaces for 3,000 students. The project also includes a thriving two-acre sky garden with native planting, pondlife and areas for relaxation. The new building – the first educational project by the practice in India – is the result of close collaboration between Foster + Partners and the University Chancellor, Dr Vijay Patil. The project achieves a LEED Platinum rating, the highest level of accreditation.

Dr Patil assembled his own construction team to work on the project, alongside a number of local craftspeople. For over a decade the team refined manufacturing and construction techniques by mocking-up components of the building on, and in close proximity to, the site. This iterative and experimental process allowed the design team to constantly refine their ideas during construction through continuous prototyping. As a result, the design of the building and its components developed and changed over several years, generating a solution that greatly improved on the initial proposals.

The new building has been designed to minimise the environmental impact associated with water and energy use, material choices and operation. The extensive use of shading minimises the energy used in mechanical cooling and the building's envelope allows in daylight while controlling glare. Wind tower assisted ventilation cools the key spaces, including the auditorium and





concourse areas. Ultra-low water consumption is also implemented across the project.

The programmatic elements of the School of Business are grouped around communal covered courtyards and carefully orientated to optimise natural daylight and space on the triangular site. The grand entrance canopy is four storeys high, with a glass roof that casts multicoloured shadows across the building's façade. An open plan reception area, exhibition space, café and informal workspace encourage social interactions between students.

At the heart of the building, four large auditoria are arranged around a sunken amphitheatre for graduation ceremonies, performances and sporting events. The

auditoria have been flexibly designed to be opened up or closed down, depending on the scale of the event. The library promotes the exchange of ideas and knowledge across four floors of the building. A sequence of tiers, balconies and stairs create a dramatic internal environment.

The scheme incorporates a palette of high-quality materials, including travertine, timber, glass reinforced concrete, aluminium and sealed concrete. Ground-granulated blast-furnace slag, or GGBS, has been added to the concrete mix in lieu of some cement, resulting in a paler concrete with a lower embodied carbon footprint. State-of-the-art furniture, designed by Foster +





Partners' own industrial design team, aids comfortable and efficient study.

The first four storeys of the building house the academic activities of the school and the five upper levels provide residential accommodation for students and faculty members. This change in function is articulated through the

cladding, which is robust and solid in appearance towards the base, visually grounding the faculty levels. Four different types of panels have been developed to clad the canteen, library, lecture theatres and administrative offices. Concrete was cast around Perspex and wooden moulds to create perforated GRC screens which push light deeper into the facade, while shading the front part of the building.

In contrast, the upper residential units are clad in lightweight cast and extruded aluminium. The corridors are naturally ventilated and offer glimpses of the spectacular two-acre sky garden which spans the full length of the building, between the academic and residential volumes.







Techo International Airport Cambodia

Foster + Partners, a British design firm, has shown the plans for Techo International Airport in Phnom Penh, Cambodia. The construction has started about 20 kilometers south of the city center. Inspired by local styles and the tropical weather, the design includes a new airport area and a terminal with a grid-shell roof that looks like a tree canopy



Located 20 kilometres south of the city centre, Techo International Airport in Phnom Penh offers a new vision for Cambodia's capital. The design embodies a strong sense of place, drawing inspiration from one of the oldest civilisations on earth, inspired by its vernacular forms, and responsive to the tropical climate. The overall masterplan by the practice includes plans for a new airport city with a state-of-the-art terminal building at its heart, providing the highest levels of passenger experience and setting new standards for sustainability.

The terminal building comprises a central head house with two aerofoil shaped piers either side that optimise walking distances. The head house contains all the passenger processing, security and immigration, and retail

elements under a single overarching roof canopy that stretches from the drop-off to the airside, providing shelter from the elements. The roof – supported by structural trees spanning 36 metres – is a lightweight steel grid shell, with an innovative screen that filters daylight and illuminates the vast terminal space. Designed to be highly legible at a human scale, there are minimal level changes throughout the terminal and views out to the apron to improve clarity and make movement intuitive. Interior materials are warm and welcoming, evoking the Cambodian vernacular in a contemporary manner.

Aspiring to be one of the greenest airports in the world, the project takes a sustainable design approach, combining the latest technology with local craftsmanship,





whilst minimising running costs. Flooded with natural light, the terminal is full of lush greenery, with mature trees rising through the soaring central void and edge planting softening the interiors. The terminal will also be almost entirely run on energy generated by an onsite photovoltaic farm.

The modular construction and phased project timeline enhance constructability. The terminal is strategically located to anticipate future expansion scenarios. The first phase of the airport terminal includes the central head house and the aerofoil wings to the north, accommodating up to 13 million passengers a year. Subsequent phases will include the second aerofoil wing, accommodating 30 million passengers.

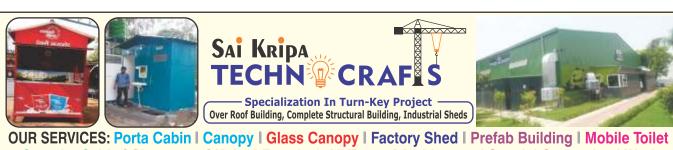

Fire Safety in India: Need to Bridge the Regulatory and Implementation Gap



India has been grappling with a concerning surge in fire-related incidents, a trend closely tied to its accelerating urbanisation. As cities expand rapidly, often through unregulated and informal settlements, fire risks have become more frequent, unpredictable, and devastating. Densely packed living and working environments rely heavily on makeshift construction, flammable materials, and illegal electrical connections. These conditions, combined with inadequate planning for emergency access and evacuation, turn even a minor spark into a full-blown disaster.

Recent tragedies, from residential building fires to industrial accidents, underscore how the lack of structural safety and emergency readiness has become a systemic failure. For instance, in April this year, 13 people lost their lives in a fire accident at a firecracker factory in Gujarat. More recently, a fire at a cooler manufacturing factory in Greater Noida took six hours, 175 firefighters, and 35 fire engines to extinguish the flames.

Despite the existence of national frameworks like the National Building Code and state-level fire safety regulations, implementation remains more in letter than spirit. Fire departments across the country face a severe shortage of stations, personnel, and equipment, resulting in delayed response times especially in congested areas or highrise developments. Moreover, most buildings lack essential safety features such as fire alarms, sprinkler systems, emergency exits, and evacuation plans.

Public apathy toward fire safety in India is deeply entrenched. Businesses rarely conduct fire drills, maintain safety records, or prioritise preventive measures. For most, fire safety remains

a box-ticking compliance activity, not a critical public safety concern. The regulatory machinery is reactive, with inspections sporadic and enforcement inconsistent. In contrast, many Western countries adopt a far more sophisticated approach standardised smoke alarms, regular drills, mandatory insurance, and widespread public sensitisation are the norm.

Fire safety is seen as integral to everyday life, not an afterthought. This lack of awareness, especially in highdensity urban settings, is dangerous. Without a cultural and institutional shift that views fire safety as core infrastructure, the risk of preventable tragedies will only grow. It's time to move beyond passive compliance to active, collective responsibility.

This systemic negligence is particularly alarming in the context of commercial spaces like retail stores and warehouses, which continue to expand rapidly in urban India but often treat fire safety as a formality rather than a foundational responsibility. In India, these establishments are subject to both national standards and state-specific fire safety obligations. They must comply with the Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS) Act, 2016, read with the Indian Standard - Selection, Installation and Maintenance of First-Aid Fire Extinguishers – Code of Practice.

For instance, a retail store

operating in Gujarat must comply with 17 distinct requirements under the BIS Act, 2016 and Gujarat Fire Prevention and Life Safety Measures Act, 2013 and Rules, 2014, while a warehouse in Karnataka has 8 unique obligations under the BIS Act, 2016 and Karnataka Fire Force Act, 1964 and Rules, 1971. Both must install appropriate fire extinguishers, water, foam, dry powder, or CO₂ at clearly visible and easily accessible locations. Monthly inspections and annual testing by trained personnel are mandatory, with operational records maintained in a register.

Each extinguisher must be properly tagged with service dates and handler identification, and 10% spare refills should be kept on-site for quick replacement. A framed fire safety plan must be displayed at the entrance, and rejected extinguishers must be destroyed to prevent misuse.

Additionally, retail stores must submit biannual safety certificates and annual declarations to the fire authorities and warehouses are required to renew their Fire Safety Certificates every two years and obtain a No Objection Certificate (NOC) from Fire and Emergency Services if operating in a high-rise facility. Similar obligations also exist in industrial and commercial establishments.

Even with this framework in place, numerous challenges persist, from violations of safety norms during construction to ambiguous provisions around periodic audits. Noncompliance is often due to outdated local bylaws, low public awareness, and poorly-equipped fire inspectors. According to the Economic Survey 2024-25, only 644 working inspectors

oversee compliance in 3,21,578 factories. This would mean one inspector oversees 500 factories, which is an example of a lack of regulatory capacity. India's regulatory capacity faces critical gaps due to a shortage of inspection personnel, inadequate testing infrastructure, outdated compliance processes, and fragmented state-level regulations.

To strengthen oversight, states can adopt structured models like Maharashtra's "Licensed Agency" mechanism. Under the Maharashtra Fire Prevention & Life Safety Measures Act, 2006 and associated Rules of 2009, these agencies are authorized to issue a Certificate (Form 'A') confirming the successful installation of fire prevention systems. Additionally, a semi-annual Certificate (Form 'B') must be issued every January and July to the owner or occupier, confirming that the installed measures are in good repair and efficient condition.

To deal with this pressing issue and minimise the impact of accidents, developers must use fire-rated materials, such as fire-resistant glass, doors, and sealants. These materials are not just regulatory additions, they actively delay the spread of flames and toxic smoke, preserve exit pathways, and protect the loadbearing elements of structures. For instance, fire-rated glass allows for visibility during emergencies while withstanding extreme heat, enabling better crowd movement and reducing panic. Further, incorporating green spaces and firebreaks can act as a barrier against fire spread.

There is also a growing consensus on the need for independent fire safety audits annually, especially in

high-occupancy buildings like malls, schools, hospitals, etc. These thirdparty audits have the potential to identify non-compliance and reduce the risk of accidents. These inspections also develop the confidence to deploy fire-safety solutions effectively and efficiently at the time of an accident. Additionally, integrating zoning policies that identify high-risk zones and limit construction in the identified areas is crucial. It can help plan wider evacuation paths, access roads for fire trucks, and mandatory fire-breaks in building clusters.

Adopting smart fire-safety devices can further improve compliance and ensure smart safety at work, eliminating the need for labour-intensive and time-consuming manual checking of fire-safety equipment. These tech-enabled tools monitor the building's fire doors, fire extinguishers and smoke detectors. In case of emergency, these tools give immediate alerts of danger. This digitised management of fire safety does away with the human errors and the costs associated with the manual checks.

Silt Soil

Sandy Soil

Sandy soil is largely composed of sand (having large particles with large spaces). It has very little clay or silt. There is extremely little humus in sandy soil. Desert locations have sandy soil. Large particles with large spaces between them distinguish sandy soil. Sandy soil has the disadvantage of not holding much water because water quickly drains through the wide pores between its particles. As a result, sandy soil dries up rapidly, which is bad for plants. Sandy soil is less fruitful than other types of soil.

Loamy Soil

Loam soil, or loamy soil, comprises the proper sand, clay, silt, and humus quantities. Loam soil comprises big and tiny rock particles that combine to form the necessary qualities. This soil type also has enough air gaps between its particles to contain the air plant roots require. As a result, it may also be readily ploughed. Chalky Soil

These soil types typically originate from being situated atop limestone or chalk bedrock. Chalky soil is typically light and easily manageable throughout the year, albeit containing stony fragments. The advantage lies in its effective drainage properties, alleviating concerns in this

regard. However, swift drainage, particularly during hot weather, can lead to soil dehydration.

A drawback of chalky soil is its alkalinity and deficiency in certain minerals like iron and manganese. Consequently, plants cultivated in such soil often exhibit stunted growth and yellowing leaves. To counteract this, it's imperative to utilise appropriate fertilisers to balance the pH for the cultivation of healthy crops.

Peat Soil

Peat soils exhibit contrasting characteristics compared to chalk, primarily due to the presence of peatdecomposing organic matter- that induces acidic conditions requiring alkalization for successful crop growth. The spongy structure of peat soil resists compaction, facilitating rapid heating and efficient water retention. Additionally, it promotes adequate aeration, enabling plant roots to respire effectively.

Notably, the scarcity of pathogens distinguishes peat soil types, making them favourable for seed germination. However, its acidic nature restricts the availability of plant nutrients, necessitating the supplementation of fertilisers for optimal crop yield. A significant drawback of peat soil is its non-renewable nature. Diminishing peat resources can exacerbate climate change by releasing greenhouse gases into the atmosphere.

What Is Earthing: Everything You Need To Know

Electrical earthing refers to discharging excess electrical current directly into the earth through a low-resistance cable.



An electric shock may occur if you touch a live metal component in your electrical system. If you want to avoid it, earthing is a good way to do so. Earthing is accomplished by allowing a fault current to flow safely to the ground through a protective conductor. It also triggers the protection mechanism (the fuse or circuit breaker) to cut power to the faulty circuit.

Electrical earthing refers to discharging excess electrical current directly into the earth through a low-resistance cable. Connecting the equipment's neutral (or the supply system's neutral) to the earth constitutes electrical earthing. If you want the answer to "what is earthing?", then read the article.

Purpose

Earthing is done so that the potential of a current-carrying conductor does not increase with respect to the earth beyond its intended insulation, preventing electrocution and fires caused by the earth leaking electricity via an undesirable channel.

The metal components of electrical appliances get charged, and static charge builds on them when they come into touch with a live wire, which may happen when the wiring in question is improperly installed, or the cable insulation is damaged. A person receives a shock by touching a charged metal.

Different Earthing Methods For Electrical Systems

- GI (galvanised iron) wire directly connects the system's neutral and the ground, or earth. This kind of earthing is known as neutral earthing or system earthing. Only systems with star winding get this kind of earthing. Electrical appliances have access to earthing equipment. Electrical equipment components that do not generate current, such as the metal frame, are grounded through the conducting wire.
- Pipe earthing is the most effective and cost-effective method of earthing. To create earth electrodes, pipes with a diameter of 38mm and a length of 2 metres are buried vertically in the ground.
- Plate earthing involves burying a copper or GI earthing plate at a depth of more than three metres below grade.
 An alternate layer of coke and salts protects this earthing plate.
- In transmission procedures, strip earthing is employed. Electrodes are laid in horizontal trenches at least 0.5 metres deep, with a cross-section of 25mm x 1.6mm for copper or 25mm x 4mm for GI or steel.

Beneficial Effects of Grounding

- In the event of a short circuit, earthing will prevent any harm to the workers.
- Even if the insulation fails, earthing still offers the simplest route for short-circuit current to pass.
- Earthing prevents damage to equipment and people from lightning and high voltage surges.
- With correct earthing, metal may be utilised in electrical systems without first checking its conductivity.

Constituents of the Earthing Infrastructure

The following are the primary parts of an all-inclusive electrical earthing system:

- Earth Continuity Conductor
- Earthing Lead
- Earth Electrode

The term "earth wire" or "earth continuity conductor" refers to the part of the earthing system that connects all of the metals in an electrical installation, such as the conduit, ducts, boxes, metallic shells of the switches, distribution boards, switches, fuses, regulating and controlling devices, metals in electrical machines like motors, generators, and transformers, and the metal framework in which electrical devices and components are installed.

Earthing: How it occurs?

To achieve earthing, the installation's components are wired to a set of electrodes or electrical wires located in or near the soil. All of the equipment's non-current-carrying metallic elements are linked to the earthing mat or electrode through a flat iron riser buried in the ground.

The term "earthing" describes the assembly that makes contact. Electrical connections are the metal wires that go between various components of an installation and the grounding system. The term "earthing system" refers to both the practice and the associated link.

An earthing joint, also known as an "earthing lead," is the connection between the earth's continuous conductor and the earth's electrode or earth plate. The earthing lead is often a hard-drawn, bare copper wire. The earth electrode (earth plat) is linked to the connecting point via an earthing lead after all earth conductors have been connected to common (or many) connecting points.

Two copper wires serve as earthing leads, connecting the device's metallic body to a ground electrode or earth plate, increasing the installation's safety factor. In other words, there will be four earthing leads if two earth electrodes or earth plates are used. To provide optimal safety, both earth's leads must function effectively to transport fault currents, and it should not be assumed that these leads are utilised as parallel pathways.

The last piece of an electrical earthing system is a metallic electrode or plate that is buried in the ground. The term "earth plate" or "earth electrode" is used to describe the metallic (plate) component of the earthing system that is buried underground and linked to earthing lead.



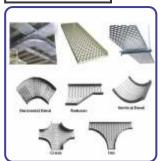
